Nursing and Midwifery - Access to Higher Education (HE) Diploma (Altrincham Campus)

Course Overview

This course is designed to prepare mature students for University level study. If you want to work in nursing, as a midwife or in related health professions this is the course for you.

In 2019-20, 96% of students on our Access Nursing & Midwifery diplomas secured offers of university places. This compares with a progression rate of just 67% across all Access diploma courses in England and Wales.

The course runs for an academic year and you will be attending three days per week for 32 weeks. You will be attending for 14.5 hours per week (13.5 hours of lessons and 1 hour of tutorial). You will also need to allow at least 6 hours per week for private study and assignment completion.

Course Requirements

This course requires you to have achieved GCSE English Language and Maths at grade C or above/ grades 4-9.

Please note that for some degree courses (e.g. Midwifery), you will also need GCSE Science at a similar grade.

The pathway will run subject to minimum numbers being reached.

Course Assessment

Assessments include essays, practical reports, case studies, open or closed-book examinations and verbal, visual or IT-based presentations. All modules will include an element of time-constrained assessment which will contribute towards the final module grade.

Upon successful completion of this course you will be awarded an Access to Higher Education Diploma from Open Awards.

Course Finance

The Tuition fee for this course is £3,384.00 You may be eligible for a full fee remission if you are in receipt of certain benefits or earning less than £20,888 per annum (if residing within Greater Manchester)
