Course Overview

A level French is a fascinating and varied subject that provides students with a broad and incredibly important range of knowledge and skills. In a world in which global relationships are often a necessity for businesses and organisations to thrive, having an additional language is extremely useful for a wide range of future careers. The course develops your ability to communicate in the language and extends your knowledge of French literature and civilisation. There are plenty of chances to improve your authentic French, as you will have small group conversation sessions each week with our French assistant.

Much of the work involves discussion and debate on important issues of interest to students; you will also have the opportunity to watch and analyse some French feature films.

Course Requirements

5 GCSEs at grade 5 or above, including a minimum of a grade 4 in English Language and Maths. A grade 6 in GCSE French is required.

Course Assessment

The A Level Linear Course is exam based. The final exam takes place at the end of the two years. Students' progress is regularly assessed with 5 Key Assessments a year, including the UCAS exam for Y12 (predicted grade for university entry) and a mock exam for Y13 (practicing in exams' conditions).
