Course Overview

If you want to work in Health & Social Care, Social Work, Primary Teaching, Law and many other careers with a strong social sciences basis, this course will provide excellent preparation for a suitable Higher Education degree.

In 2019-20, 100% of students on our Access Social Sciences diplomas secured offers of university places. This compares with a progression rate of just 67% across all Access diploma courses in England and Wales.

The course runs over 3 days per week, classes between 9am and 3 or 4pm each day.

Course Requirements

The course requires you to have achieved GCSE English Language and Maths at grade C or above/grades 4-9.

The pathway will run subject to minimum numbers being reached.

Course Assessment

Assessments include essays, practical reports, case studies, open or closed-book examinations and verbal, visual or IT-based presentations. All modules will include an element of time-constrained

assessment which will contribute towards the final module grade.
