Normal minimum qualifications required for mature entrants (21 years and above) are a recognised Computing Access course or business experience in the computing industry using IT related skills and successful completion of an aptitude assessment in maths and English Language. Applications from mature students without formal qualifications will be welcomed, especially if you have the motivation to succeed.
