Course Overview

This is a 'First Steps' programme which gives learners a taste of different vocational sectors such as art & design, construction crafts, gas and plumbing, motor vehicle, hair and beauty, hospitality and catering, digital, science and business, sport and public services. It is perfect for learners who have not yet made their mind up about which subject they would like to study and to boost their English and maths skills. On successful completion of the course, learners can progress to a L1 qualification in their chosen sector.

Course Requirements

4 GCSE's at Grade 1 or above including English and maths

An interview with a member of staff from the Progression Curriculum plus a good reference from school/college.

Course Assessment

Assessment consists of both performance evidence and knowledge evidence.

Performance evidence through direct observation and oral questioning.
